„International Cooperation and Development – Building partnerships for change in developing countries“

- Projekte müssen zur Verbesserung der Situation eines Entwicklungslandes führen (Fokus auf Vor-Ort-Aktivitäten/teilweise Aktivitäten in EU i.O.)
- Keine reinen Forschungs-, sondern Anwendungsprojekte (bis auf wenige Ausnahmen), Projekte können aber bspw. Studien, Analysen, Pilotprojekte beinhalten
- Schwerpunkt: Human Capacity Building im weiteren Sinne

Wer kann sich bewerben?

Anforderungskriterien „Lead Partner“

- Rechtsperson („legal person“), und
- Private und öffentliche Organisationen (“NGOs, private or public sector operator, local or national authority, an international [inter-governmental] organisation”), und
- aus EU Mitgliedstaat bzw. ausschreibungsspezifischen Ländern, und
- offiziell registriert (Ausnahme: int. Organisationen), und
- Direkt verantwortlich für die Antragserstellung und Implementation des Projekts (kein “intermediary”), und
- ...
- **Co-applicants and affiliates** must satisfy the eligibility criteria as applicable to the lead applicant!
- Sonstige Beteiligte: Associates, Contractors – keine Verpflichtung wie oben

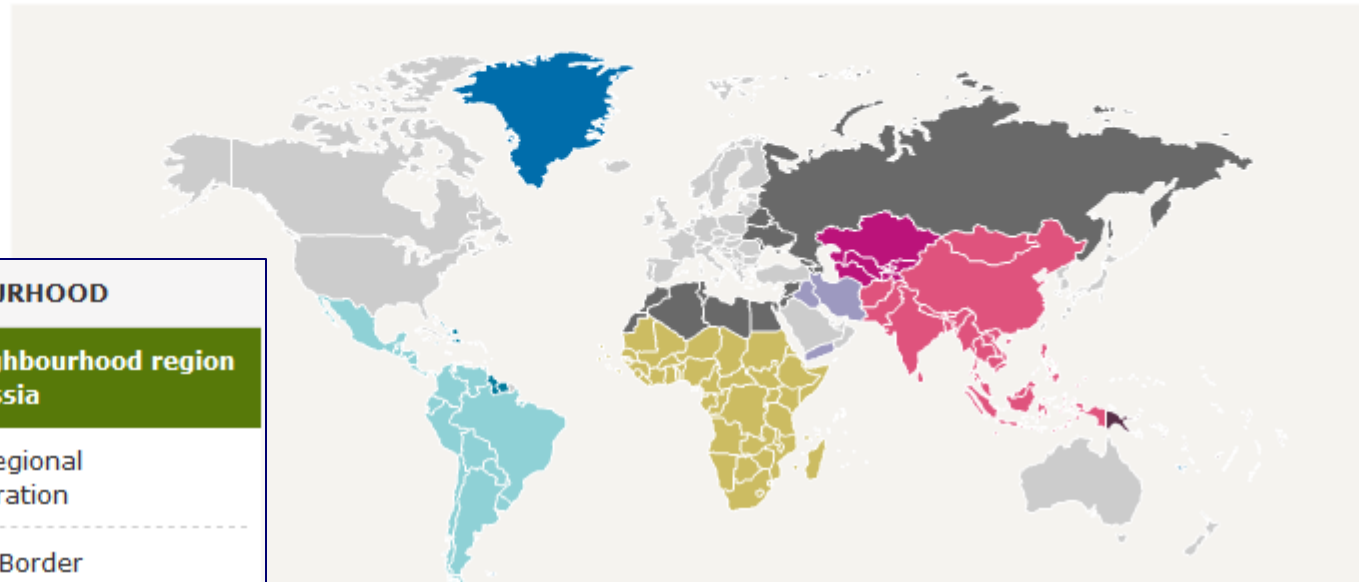

Action Grants:

- Ko-Finanzierung notwendig
 - i.d.R. 15-20% v. Gesamtbudget
- Eligible costs
 - direkte Kosten (Personal, Reisekosten, Büromaterial, Equipment, sonstiges)
 - indirekte Kosten (7% flat rate)
- Non-eligible costs
 - Währungsschwankungen
 - Zinsen usw.

- i.d.R. 2-stufiger Prozess, ca. 80h Zeitaufwand über 6-8 Wochen
 - concept note + full application)
- Antragseinreichung nur noch online
 - PADOR Registration (EuropeAid ID) und elektronische Einreichung (PROSPECT) verpflichtend
- Verhältnis bewilligte vs eingereichte Projekte: 7-8 % ü.a. thematischen Bereiche (Stand 2012/eingereichte Projekte)
